

GRAND OPENING OF THE CAIRNS CENTRE

This stunning new centre opened its doors in December 2010.

Aged Care Plus opened the doors of The Cairns Aged Care Centre in the Brisbane suburb of Chapel Hill in December 2010.

Named after Commissioner William Cairns, Aged Care Plus' new 126-bed centre will operate a range of residential aged care services including high and low care. There is also a Memory Support Unit to support residents with dementia.

Not only will it be home for 126 residents, but its on-site hobby farm has been carefully created for multi-generational appeal. Designed to attract and charm

visitors of all ages, it is hoped the farm will also provide therapeutic activities for residents.

The beautifully designed and finished centre also features a chapel, single and twin rooms with ensuites, large balconies, a library, kitchen areas, garden, internet cafe, hairdressing salon, aviary and a hobby farm.

At the official opening, the CEO Sharon Callister emphasized that individual care will be for the whole person -physical, emotional and spiritual, in an atmosphere of dignity and respect.
