RE: NEW MASK REQUIREMENTS FOR VICTORIA

You may be aware that a positive case of COVID-19 has been identified in Victoria and as a result, masks are now required to be worn in all indoor public spaces. This new rule came into effect at 11:59pm on Wednesday, 3 February 2021, and will be in place until otherwise advised. As per the website, in addition to indoor public spaces, face masks continue to be mandatory when working in or visiting aged care centres and we appreciate your continued support in this regard.
