RE: MANDATORY MASKS IN METROPOLITAN MELBOURNE AND MITCHELL SHIRE

Dear All,

As of 11:59pm on Wednesday 22 July, all those who live and work in Metropolitan Melbourne and Mitchell Shire who are over the age of 12 will now be required to wear a mask when leaving their home. There are \$200 fines for people who don't comply with this new rule.

The Stage 3 "Stay at Home" restrictions are still in place and you are only allowed to leave home for one of the following four reasons: shopping for food and supplies, outdoor exercise and recreation, medical care and caregiving, and study or work – if you can't do it from home.

As a reminder, once the mask is secured, you shouldn't touch your face and when you have finished using the mask, please dispose of it safely. We understand that this is a difficult time and that wearing a mask might be an inconvenience but the wellbeing of our clients and staff is our utmost priority.
