RE: AN UPDATE FOR SEAFORTH GARDENS AGED CARE CENTRE

Dear All,

We are writing to advise you that the Western Australian Government has declared the 3-day lockdown as communicated to you on 23 April 2021 complete as of 12:01am, Tuesday, 27 April 2021. However, there will be a post-lockdown transition phase for the Perth and Peel regions of Western Australia which will last until 12:01am, Saturday, 1 May 2021. This means that residential aged care centres in these areas will only be allowed to permit visitors for compassionate reasons and advocacy.

As Seaforth Gardens is located in Perth, this post-lockdown measure will apply to your Centre. We also will be keeping your Centre at Risk Level 5 on our internal Risk Assessment Matrix until otherwise advised. Thank you for your continued support and understanding.
