## RE: A NEW AGED CARE DIRECTION FOR QUEENSLAND

Dear All,

We are writing to advise you that the Queensland Government, in conjunction with Queensland Health, released a new Aged Care Direction at 11am on 14 January 2021. Aged Care Direction (No. 20) is now in effect and it revokes the previous Direction (No.19).

According to the new Direction, your Residential Aged Care Centre is a Non-Restricted Facility as it is not located within the current <u>restricted Local Government Areas</u> within the Metro North, Metro South and West Moreton Hospital and Health Service regions (City of Brisbane, City of Ipswich, Lockyer Valley Region, Logan City, Moreton Bay Region, Redland City, Scenic Rim Region, Somerset Region).
