RE: UPDATED ADVICE FOR THE ACT REGARDING COVID-19

Dear All,

On 19 January 2021, the ACT Government, in conjunction with ACT Health, released updated advice on the interstate outbreaks of COVID-19 in Australia. We are writing to bring your attention to this advice which includes the following key points:

- Anyone who has been in a geographical area of risk should not visit or work in a high-risk setting for 14 days after leaving the affected area.
- Under a Public Health Direction, anyone in the ACT who has been to a COVID-19 affected area in the last 14 days must quarantine until 14 days after they were last in these areas.

Please note that according to ACT Health, high-risk settings include residential aged care centres and that the geographical areas of risk, which are updated regularly, can be found at the following link:
