RE: NEW DIRECTIVE FOR QUEENSLAND

Dear All,

We are writing to advise you of Queensland Aged Care Direction (No. 25) which has come into effect from 5pm 29 March 2021 which can be reviewed here:

Therefore, the following is now in place:

- Visitors are restricted to residential aged care facilities [within the State of Queensland](#) unless providing end of life support.
- Anyone entering a facility must wear a single use surgical face mask.

Given this new directive, we have reviewed our Risk Assessment Matrix and all of our Centres within Queensland will be at Risk Level 5 until otherwise advised.

Please be aware, if you develop flu-like symptoms, you should stay at home if you are a permitted visitor or notify the Centre Manager if you are a resident. As always, if you have any questions, please get in touch with your Centre Manager.
