Please see below the following updates for Seaforth Gardens Aged Care Centre which will be effective from Monday, 7 September 2020.

- All visitors are to be screened at the administration building prior to entry into the centre. You also need to sign out from the same location;
- Visiting hours will be from 9:30am to 12noon and from 1:00pm to 4.00pm;

If you wish to visit outside the above times, please contact the Centre Manager to discuss.

We ask that you still maintain good hand hygiene which includes washing your hands regularly and using hand sanitiser. We also ask that you keep the physical distancing requirements of 1.5 metres in mind when visiting your loved one.

If you have symptoms of respiratory illness including a cough or a cold, or if you have a fever or have lost your sense of taste or smell, we ask that you do not visit the Centre if you are permitted to do so.
