RE: UPDATED DIRECTIVES RELEASED BY NSW HEALTH

Dear All,

We are writing to advise you that on 13 March 2021, NSW Health released new directives for residential aged care centres in New South Wales. According to these new directives, the following will now be in place at your Centre:

Restrict access for people who have been to:

- Greater Brisbane since 11 March 2021 this includes Brisbane City, Ipswich, Logan, Moreton Bay and Redland
- Auckland, New Zealand in the last 14 days (in exceptional circumstances contact the Public Health Unit for advice).

In terms of recent COVID-19 case locations in New South Wales, there are restrictions for visitors, staff and residents of residential aged care centres who have been to any of the locations at the date and time listed on the <u>close contact</u> or <u>casual contact</u> list in the past 14 days.
