RE: UPDATED DIRECTIVES FROM NSW HEALTH

Dear All,

We are writing to advise you that NSW Health updated their directives for residential aged care centres in New South Wales again and, as of 23 February 2021, the following is now in effect in all of our New South Wales Centres. This is in addition to the changes communicated to you yesterday:

- The restriction on people who had been to New Zealand since 15 February 2021 has been removed;
- The Melbourne Airport Holiday Inn has been removed from the Interstate and Overseas Area of Concern. Restrictions still apply for people who have visited Victorian [venues of concern](#) (Case alerts – public exposure sites) at the dates and times listed.
