We are writing to advise you that on 25 February 2021, NSW Health released updated directives for residential aged care centres in New South Wales. According to these new directives, NSW Health require residential aged care centres in New South Wales to restrict access for people who have been to:

- Auckland, New Zealand in the last 14 days (in exceptional circumstances, contact the Public Health Unit for advice).
