RE: AN UPDATE TO THE QUEENSLAND COVID-19 HOTSPOT LIST

Dear All,

On 18 December 2020, the Queensland Government issued a media release stating there have been new cases of COVID-19 identified in Queensland which you can review here: https://www.health.qld.gov.au/news-events/doh-media-releases/releases/queensland-covid-19-update6

The media release also states that the Sydney's Northern Beaches Local Government Area of New South Wales will be declared a hotspot from 1am Saturday 19 December. According to the latest Aged Care Direction (No 15), the following still applies to all residential aged care centres in Queensland:

A person must not enter, or remain on, the premises of a residential aged care facility in the State of Queensland from the time of publication of this direction until the end of the declared public health emergency if:

• during the 14 days immediately preceding the entry, the person has been in a place which at the time of entry is a **COVID-19 hotspot**

Based on this information, anyone who has travelled from Sydney's Northern Beaches Local Government Area during the 14 days preceding entry will not be permitted to enter our residential aged care centres in Queensland until the hotspot has been revoked.

In addition, as there have been new cases of COVID-19 identified in Queensland, we ask that you remain vigilant over the coming weeks. Please maintain physical distancing and good hand hygiene when visiting. If you have any symptoms of COVID-19, we ask that you do not visit your loved one and rather seek advice from your General Practitioner or call the Coronavirus hotline.
