RE: THE USE OF THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES AT WARRINGAH PLACE
RETIREMENT VILLAGE

Dear All,

As you are now aware, in light of the feedback we received from our residents at Warringah Place Retirement Village, we have eased the restrictions as they relate to our recreational facilities. From Saturday, 1st August 2020 the following is now in place:

- The use of the swimming pool will be for residents only. No visitors or children will be permitted to use the swimming pool;
- 4 people will be permitted to use the swimming pool at any one time;
- 2 people will be permitted to use the spa at any one time;
- 2 people will be permitted to use the gym at any one time;
- A total of 8 people will be permitted to use the facilities at any one time;
- All those using the facilities will be required to sign in and use hand sanitiser;
- Those using the gym must use the sanitised wipes on the equipment before and after use;
- There will be a single point of entry to the gym and this will be the internal entrance through the Atrium.

We do appreciate your feedback with regards to the use of the facilities and your consideration given these new requirements. It's our utmost priority to keep everyone safe and we thank you for your understanding and continued support.
