RE: A CHANGE IN RISK LEVEL

Dear Residents,

As you may be aware, there have been confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the Northern Beaches. The Chief Health Officer has issued the following advice which we have implemented at Elizabeth Jenkins Place and Pacific Lodge effective immediately:

- There should be a temporary 3 day pause on visitation to residential aged care centres;
- Any staff who have attended any of the venues visited by the confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 are to immediately be excluded from the centre and be tested for COVID-19. The venues are listed at the following website:

- Any staff with symptoms should be tested for COVID-19 and excluded from the centre.

Based on this information, we will be moving to a high level of vigilance at the Village. As a precaution and effective immediately, the following will now apply:

- No visitors, volunteers or non-essential contractors permitted to visit the Village, except contractors providing essential services such as cleaners, kitchen staff, emergency tradespeople and some allied health providers.
- No visitors will be permitted to access the pool area;
- Temperature checks will continue for all parties entering the Village common areas;
- Group activities will remain at this time but applying the 4 square metre rule and keeping groups small.

If you have visited any of the following areas listed below, we encourage you get tested for COVID-19 and self-isolate and please advise myself or Sue Frost as a precaution as our team is happy to facilitate any testing that you may need to access.
