RE: UPDATE TO CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) RESTRICTIONS

From Monday 22 June 2020, visiting restrictions will ease for aged care centres in Tasmania in line with public health advice. Following consultation with the aged care sector, these changes include:

- up to two people per visit with visit times unrestricted and multiple visits allowed in one day, subject to centre policy;
- persons under the age of 16 will be allowed to visit an aged care centre;
- visiting services such as hairdressers and allied health professionals will be able to attend a centre; and
- residents will be allowed to leave the centre, for example with friends and family.

Please note that all other restrictions remain in place and that the above changes will be implemented at Barrington Lodge from Monday 22 June. Temperature checks will still take place on arrival. During business hours, our receptionist will attend to this and after hours, our Registered Nurse will assist.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind you to please be cautious in light of the easing of restrictions and to maintain hand hygiene and social distancing practices, particularly in public places. We would also like to encourage the flu vaccination for people if residents are to come into contact with them. Additionally, we'd like to remind you that if you or your loved one is unwell, or if you or they have travelled within the last 14 days, not to visit the elderly.
