Location that keeps you connected

Set in the heart of Arncliffe, Macquarie Lodge Retirement Village offers a perfect balance between peaceful residential living and easy access to everything you need. It's quiet and settled, without ever feeling isolated.

Local centres including Wolli Creek, Rockdale, Kogarah and Hurstville are all within 15 minutes, offering shopping, dining and everyday essentials. Brighton-Le-Sands is just a 10-minute drive away, perfect for beach walks and picnics.

Arncliffe railway station is a 5-minute drive from the Village, with trains reaching Central Station in under 20 minutes. Sydney Airport is 15 minutes away, and a public bus stop is conveniently located at the Village entrance.

For residents who drive, secure entry and underground parking is available at the Village, with direct lift access to the apartments.

For those who don't drive, or prefer not to, the village bus runs weekly shopping trips to Rockdale Plaza, along with other outings shaped by residents' preferences.

Residents can access government-subsidised Support at Home services through **Salvos Home Care**, including nursing care, therapies, personal care and help with housework - all while continuing to live independently in their own apartment.

Furthermore, if you or your partner ever need short-term support after a hospital stay, or longer-term residential care, **Macquarie Lodge Aged Care Centre** is located nearby. This means one partner can continue living independently in the Village, while having the peace of mind that their loved one is close by and supported with compassionate, 24-hour care — whenever it's needed.

A rich history — the Dappeto story

Dappeto House, located alongside Macquarie Lodge, is a treasured part of the village. Built in 1885, this beautifully restored High Victorian mansion is one of the finest examples of its kind.

Originally built by oyster merchant Frederick Gibbins, the property was purchased by The Salvation Army in 1917 and has served the community ever since. Today, Dappeto House provides a special place for family gatherings, resident events and moments of reflection.

A place where history and community continue to be shared.
