Location that keeps you connected

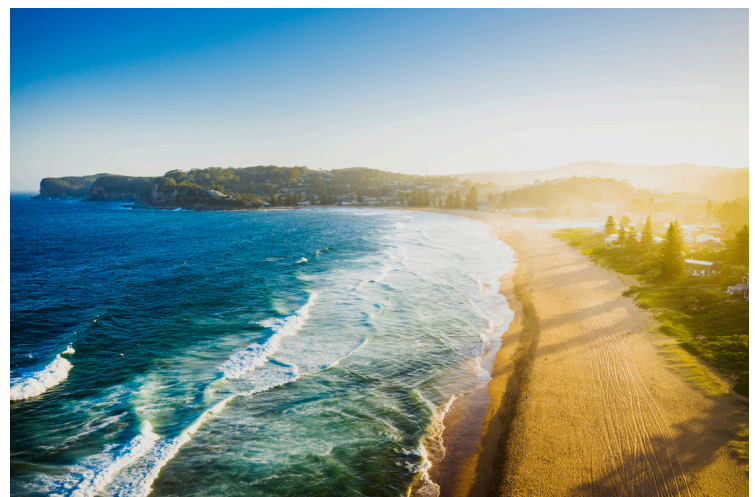


